Great job to ALL of these awesome Mustangs for stepping up as Leaders!


Students will be voting for the leaders this afternoon and the winners will be announced at the end of the day! (stay tuned to Montana City School's Facebook page for results!)

- The parking lot is a cell phone free zone






You are more than welcome to drop your kids off at one of the designated meeting spots listed below, or join us for the walk!

In Cases of Illness

My child is sick. How can I get their homework? First, if your child is home sick, it is best to let them rest, heal up and get back to school, the teachers can catch them up upon their return. To have homework collected please email your child's homeroom teacher.
